The Association of Guernsey Charities is a membership organisation for charities in the Bailiwick of Guernsey. The Association promotes the benefits of the charitable sector, and is a forum for local organisations to meet and discuss matters of mutual interest or concern.

This form is for your organisation to apply for membership of the Association of Guernsey Charities. It should be noted that membership is not automatically conferred, but instead, your application (together with supporting paperwork) will be considered by the Council of the Association.

You will be notified by the Membership Secretary if your application has been accepted and your details will be included on the Associations' website. These details are taken from this form, so it is vital that all questions are answered fully. Please also remember to notify the Membership Secretary of any changes to your organisation, or to the contact details, so that our records will be accurate.

#### Contacts

The Membership Application Form requires two sets of contact details. The first contact will be sent all official correspondence from the Association (e.g. Notice and Agenda for meetings, relevant information about sector, charity/volunteer communications, etc.) and should be a senior person within your organisation.

The second contact is the person whom the public may contact your organisation. These details will be included on our website.

#### Charity Registration

The Association of Guernsey Charities is neither a regulator nor an official register of charities. The Charities and Non Profit Organisation (Registration) (Guernsey) Law, 2008 requires all Non Profit organisations based in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou to register with the Office of the Registrar. A failure to do so is an offence. However there is an exemption from this requirement which applies to organisations with gross assets and funds of less than £10,000, or gross annual income of less than £5,000.

If your organisation is within the first year of operation, then you should send proof that you have a bank account for your organisation.
- Association of Guernsey Charities joining fee - **£10** (Either cheque or BACS transfer)
